Phase Three of the Lake Water Sewer Project is About to Begin. The next phase of the project to replace the aging sewer system around Big Waverly Lake as well as installation of city water to all homes around the Lake will be underway this week. This is a two year project that will take the water/sewer lines from the Elementary School down Co Rd 9 to Co Rd 8, down 8 to North Shore and then along North Shore Drive nearly to the intersection with Elder. In 2019, we expect that a lift station will be installed in Railroad Park near the underpass and that all sewer and water lines will be placed from that lift station down Co Rd 9 past the school to Co Rd 8 and then along 8 to North Shore. Water lines and the new sewer system on North Shore will be built in 2020. The first thing that will be done is the directional drilling of the lines along Co Rd 9 past the school. This may cause some traffic disruptions during the day and you may

see road closed signs when work is being done. Local traffic will still get thru. These signs are supposed to be removed at night and during the week end. Fortunately, directional drilling does not require tearing the street up. The residents directly affected will be updated every week by email and an update will be posted on the City Web site.

This is a friendly reminder – if you have a dog, please be sure to get a license from City Hall. This makes it much easier to locate you if your dog gets lost. Also – and frankly many, many complaints are received on this one – when you walk your dog **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET!!!** None of us want to run into dog debris when we are out walking and we certainly do not want our kids stepping in it when they are playing in their own yard or in the neighborhood park. So **PLEASE** take that bag and clean up after your dog.

Finally, remember that you are always welcome to attend our Council meetings which are at 7:00 pm on the second Tuesday of every month.
