**ROAD CONSTRUCTION IN WAVERLY!** A major road construction project affecting everyone in Waverly using County Rd 9 for any reason will begin this spring and continue throughout the summer. County Road 9 (Dempsey Ave., S.W.) from Atlantic Avenue to North Shore Drive will be inaccessible to through traffic from early spring to late summer. Detours will be posted but plan on extra travel time if you normally take this route to travel to Buffalo or go other places north of the City.

This is a joint City /Wright County project. The city is installing city water and a new sewer system along the east side of the Lake and is constructing a sidewalk/biking/walking trail on the east side of the road. The County is reconstructing this portion of County Rd 9 to state aid standards which will mean a slightly wider road. This is the first project funded with the designated one-half percent sales tax enacted by the County last year to pay for new transportation projects.

We realize that this project will cause some inconvenience but in the end we will have a better and a safer road for all to use. **Memorial Day Monday, May 28.** The American Legion Post 305 and Auxiliary are planning a very special Memorial Day commemorating the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War One. The day will start at 10:30 am with a parade with all veterans wearing their original service uniforms. A service in Railroad Park will follow at 11:00 am with speaker World War One expert Rick Lammers of Howard Lake.

The Service will honor all veterans from the Civil War to the present with a special emphasis this year on World War One veterans.

Following the service everyone will be able to see the Minnesota Military Museum's WWI Traveling Trunk which includes a number of items used and worn by the Doughboys serving in France. This will be displayed in City Hall along with other WWI exhibits. All persons with Waverly ties that served in World War One will be honored at the Memorial Day Ceremony in Railroad Park, and will be included in a special Waverly WWI Commemorative Book being prepared by the Legion and Auxiliary. Members of the Waverly Fire Department will serve refreshments following the Parade and Railroad Park Ceremony.

**Waverly Daze Friday – Sunday, July 6– 8.** Legion Park will again be the location for the 2018 Waverly Daze Celebration which will begin July 8 with family night and Fireworks across the Lake at 10 pm. The Lions and KC's with the help of the Fire Department, Royalty Committee, Boosters, Lake Association and other community groups are planning for a great three day event.
