NEWSLETTER – WINTER 2020

There have been some changes in city staff: Long time Maintenance Supervisor Jim Voitalla retired on December 31, 2019 and Jason Karels was named the new supervisor. Nick Kizer is second in command of the department and they are joined by Andy Jacobson (new to the staff early last spring) and Joey Kittock who started on January 2 this year. Alica First officially joined Deb Ryks, Chris Kittock, and Mary Klingelhoets on the administrative staff as our receptionist on January 2nd after filling that role for 6 months on a temporary basis.

Mark your calendars for the following events this winter:

February 28, 2020: The annual, and very popular, Lions **Fish Fry** will be held at Village Hall from 3:30 – 7:00 pm. Plan to come early to this well attended event as the fish is usually gone before 7:00! Take out will be available.

March 3, 2020: Minnesota’s PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY. For all those living within the City of Waverly, the polling place is at City Hall from 7 am – 8 pm.

March 14, 2020: **St Patrick’s Day** in Waverly will include a parade thru downtown starting at 1:00 pm followed by events and games for the kids in Village Hall. (Of course, St Pat’s Day will be celebrated ALL day at the UpTown and the Muni – see each establishment for planned events.)

And, **looking ahead** because spring and summer will come eventually:

May 28, 2020: **Memorial Day Parade and Services**, with the parade at 10:30 am and Services in Railroad Park at 11:00 am. An open house will be held at the Fire Barn following the Service. (In case of rain the service will be in the Fire Barn.)

July 10-12, 2020: The **Annual Waverly Daze Celebration** will be held in Legion Park with the tractor show in Railroad Park. The Parade will be at 1:00 pm on Sunday, July 12. Watch the city website for details.

Snow Reminders: There are a couple of months of winter remaining so just to remind – there is no parking on city streets from 2 – 7 am thru March 31st and if it snows, please keep your car

off the street to allow for plows to come thru. Garbage cans should be placed in the drive (not in the street), and please clean out around your mailboxes and fire hydrants!

A Park Survey is Coming

The Waverly Parks Commission is working on a survey that will be sent to all residents in mid Spring. The Commission wants your ideas for improvements/additions that you would like to see in our many parks. Any and all ideas will be welcome and will be used to guide the parks five year plan and budget. The survey will be available online thru the City Web site, in hard copy and possibly other sources.

Plan ahead for road closures this spring and summer.

Although it is early, we want to advise you that we will once again have some extended road closures around the Lake beginning in mid to late spring. Phase Three of the Lake Water and Sewer Project will be completed with the installation of a new gravity feed sewer system along North Shore Drive from County Road 8 to near the intersection with Elder. North Shore will be closed to through traffic along this stretch for most of the summer. A temporary road is being constructed but use will be limited to residents along that stretch of North Shore Drive. Affected residents will receive weekly emails on construction progress and updates will be available on the home page of the city web site.
