**CLEAN UP DAY:** is scheduled on June 2 from 7 am to 11 am at City Hall. Bring your unwanted junk, including furniture and electronics, to City Hall where there will be dumpsters available. Staff will help you unload. Karels Brothers will be accepting tires, automotive batteries and metals. There is a \$10 per load charge. **Clean Up Day is open to Waverly City Residents ONLY! Identification will be checked.**

Now that spring has come, we would like to remind you of a few “rules and regulations” that will make all of our lives a little easier and more pleasant as we are finally able to enjoy the outdoors and summertime recreation.

**DOGS– PLEASE LICENSE YOUR DOG AND PLEASE! CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET!!!** Please license your pet so that if they get lost the city can quickly find you and your pet can safely return home.

Clean up – well that goes without saying. None of us want to run into dog debris when we are out walking and we certainly do not want our kids stepping in it when they are playing in their own yard or in the park. **So PLEASE – clean up after your dog.**

**BOAT AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING** –Boats, campers, trailers, etc. can only be parked on city streets for a 24 hour period before they must be moved. This includes parking on dead ends, cul-de-sacs and street stubs. If you need to have your boat, trailer, or recreational vehicle on the street for more than 24 hours contact city hall for a special 72 hour permit. You could receive a ticket if your recreational vehicle is on the street for more than 24 hours. And, yes, this applies to construction trailers as well, so if you notice any work trailers, or construction trailers parked in the street for more than 24 hours notify the city and staff will take the appropriate action.

**WEEDS and YARDS** – You will receive a notice from the city if there are weeds or grass longer than 8 inches on your yard. If the problem remains, the city will cut the grass or weeds and you will be billed. And, yes, we notify contractors also and DO cut their lots when they do not.

**Memorial Day Monday, May 28.** The American Legion Post 305 and Auxiliary are planning a very special Memorial Day commemorating the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War One. The day will start at 10:30 am with a parade with all veterans wearing their original service uniforms. A service in Railroad Park will follow at 11:00 am with speaker World War One expert Rick Lammers of Howard Lake. The Service will honor all veterans from the Civil War to the present with a special emphasis this year on World War One veterans.

Following the service everyone will be able to see the Minnesota Military Museum's WWI Traveling Trunk which includes a number of items used and worn by the Doughboys serving in France. This will be displayed in City Hall along with other WWI exhibits. All persons with Waverly ties will be included in a special Waverly WWI Commemorative Book being prepared by the Legion and Auxiliary and available at City Hall. Members of the Waverly Fire Department will serve refreshments following the Parade and Railroad Park Ceremony.

**Waverly Daze Friday – Sunday, July 6– 8.** Legion Park will again be the location for the 2018 Waverly Daze Celebration which will begin July 6 with family night and Fireworks across the Lake at 10 pm. The Lions and KC's with the help of the Fire Department, Royalty Committee, Boosters, Lake Association and other community groups are planning for a great three day event.
